

REGULATIONS FOR STAYS WITH ANIMALS

- 1. At the time of booking, please let us know if you would like to bring your pet, and we will make sure that a suitable room is prepared. The receptionist will help you choose the ideal room taking into account the size of your four-legged friend.
- 2. The price for the pet is PLN 40 /day.
- 3. Every dog receives a welcome kit as a present from us.
- 4. In selected public areas: corridors, patios of the Restaurant or the relaxation area next to the buildings, please keep your pet on a leash.
- 5. When spending time with your pet, please be considerate of the comfort of other guests.
- 6. Please bring your dog's or cat's health booklet with current vaccinations and deworming confirmation to present at the reception.
- 7. For your comfort during your stay, your room will be cleaned when you notify the Reception of your preferred time.
- 8. If your pet likes to spend time on the sofa or bed, please secure this area with a mat. When leaving your pet alone in the room, please inform the Reception desk.
- 9. You are kindly requested to clean up after your pet within the property and the adjacent area. Special bags are available at the upper car park.
- 10. The owner of the pet is responsible for any damage during the stay. The property reserves the right to charge the guest's bill commensurate to any damage caused.
- 11. We do not accept stays of dog breeds deemed to be aggressive. The list of aggressive dog breeds is based on the Regulation of the Minister of Internal Affairs and Administration of 28 April 2003 and Administration dated 28 April 2003: Pit bull terrier, Mallorca dog, American bulldog, Argentine dog, Canary dog, Tosa inu, Rottweiler, Akbash dog, Anatolian carabash, Moscow guard dog, Caucasian sheepdog.
