PRIVACY POLICY AND USE OF COOKIES

We respect the privacy of our Users and therefore make this Privacy Policy available so that each User knows to what extent her/his personal data is processed and can decide independently, consciously and freely whether to use our portal. This Privacy Policy sets out the principles for the processing and protection of the personal data provided by you in connection with the use of the services offered by the Healing Village web portal located at <http://wioskazdrowia.pl/> (the "Portal").

Personal Data Administrator

The administrator of your personal data is Łubinowe Wzgórze Sp. z o.o with its registered office in Łąki 45A, 24-160 Wąwolnica ("Administrator").

Principles of processing your personal data

In order to ensure the security of the personal data entrusted to it, the Administrator operates on the basis of internal procedures and recommendations, in compliance with the relevant legal acts on the protection of personal data, and in particular with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons in relation to the relation to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46 EC.

The controller shall take special care to protect the interests of the data subjects, and in particular shall ensure, that personal data are:

- a. processed lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner,
- b. collected for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes and not further processed in a way incompatible with those purposes,
- c. adequate, relevant and limited to what is necessary for the purposes for which they are processed,
- d. Correct and updated when necessary,
- e. kept in a form which permits your identification for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the purposes for which the personal data are processed,
- f. processed in a manner that ensures appropriate security of personal data, including protection against unauthorised or unlawful processing and accidental loss, destruction or damage, by appropriate technical or organisational measures.

Your rights

You have the right to access your personal data processed by the Administrator. You also have the right to rectify, restrict or stop the processing of your data and to request its transfer to another entity at any time. At any time, you may also object to the processing of your data or withdraw your previously granted consent to the processing of your data and request the deletion of your personal data from the Portal. However, the withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing that was carried out on the basis of your consent before its withdrawal. You also have the right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority in charge of personal data protection, i.e. the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.

Legal basis for processing

Your personal data is processed on the basis of your consent.

How do we collect personal data?

The Administrator performs the functions of obtaining information about Portal users in the following ways:

- a. through voluntarily entered information in the contact form,
- b. through the collection of "cookies". Your personal data as a user of <http://wioskazdrowia.pl> are not sold or made available to third parties.

How long do we keep your personal data?

Your personal data may be stored until you withdraw your consent to its processing, but no longer than the statute of limitations for possible claims relating to the purposes for which we processed your personal data. To what extent do we use automated decision-making, including profiling? We do not use to any extent or degree of automated decision-making, in particular profiling.

Contact form

The Administrator processes the personal data voluntarily provided by you, for the sole purpose of responding to the enquiry addressed by you to the Administrator using the contact form, as follows:

- a. first and last name
- b. e-mail address
- c. telephone number

Providing the Administrator with this personal data is necessary in order to enable the Administrator to contact you and answer your questions.

Cookies

This Cookie Policy applies to the Portal. By using the Portal you consent to the use of cookies in accordance with in accordance with this Cookie Policy. If you do not agree to our use of cookies, you should change your browser settings in an appropriate manner or refrain from using the Portal.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small files that are saved and stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone when you visit various websites on the internet. A cookie usually contains the name of the website from which it originated, the "lifespan" of the cookie (i.e. how long it has been in existence), and a randomly generated unique number used to identify the browser from which you connect to the website.

What do we use cookies for?

The portal uses cookies for various purposes:

- To make the portal run faster and easier to use.
- To collect anonymous, aggregated statistics that allow us to understand how people use our sites and help us improve their functionality and content.
- By using cookies in the manner described above, we never identify users by the information stored in cookies.

How long is data stored in cookies?

Two types of cookies may be used on the Portal - session cookies and permanent cookies. The former remain on your device only while you are using the Portal. Permanent cookies remain on your device for as long as they have a set lifespan or until you delete them.

Types of cookies used on the Portal

Necessary for the operation of the pages - essential for the proper functioning of the Portal, they allow you to navigate pages and to use their elements. For example, they may remember previous activities (e.g. open texts) when you return to the site in the same session. Improving performance - Gathering information about how visitors use the Portal by providing information about the areas they visit, the time they spend on them and the problems they encounter, such as error messages. This allows us to improve the Portal's performance.

Do we use third party cookies?

Yes, by using the Portal you may receive cookies from third parties that cooperate with the Portal, such as Facebook or Google. You can find more information about these cookies on the individual third party websites.

How do I change or delete my cookie settings?

Most web browsers are initially set up to accept cookies automatically. You can, however, change your browser settings so that cookies are blocked - in whole or in part, e.g. only from third parties, or that you receive a message every time a cookie is sent to your device. Please note, however, that if you block the cookies we use, it may negatively affect your convenience of using the Portal, for example you may not be able to be unable to visit certain areas of the Portal or not receive personalised information as you browse through them. You also prevent us from collecting anonymous information regarding your use of our sites in order to continually improve our Portal.

Links to other sites

The portal contains links to other websites. The Administrator cannot be held responsible for the privacy policy of these websites. We urge you to familiarise yourself with the privacy policy set out there when you go to other sites. This privacy policy applies only to the Portal.
